POSITION REQUIREMENTS:

Completion of Practical Nursing School with 1 year Acute Care Nursing experience preferred

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

Assesses, treats, and educates patients to ensure safe, effective, appropriate patient care. Monitors work environment to ensure safe and efficient operations. Under the general supervision of a Registered Nurse, incumbent is responsible for 1 (12 hour) shift up to three days per week and overtime and call back as required by TCH.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

Skill and proficiency in applying technical principles, concepts and knowledge relative to the position. Ability to use initiative and make independent decisions. Ability to implement, educate, and adapt changes in the patient care process.

Employee must have a satisfactory work performance record including an acceptable attendance record, performance evaluations and a history of positive, pleasant inter-relationships with the coworkers and other hospital staff as well as Medical Staff.

- ◆ Implements, and administers Nursing Policies and Procedures by providing leadership to and involving staff who serve clinic practice to assure a safe, quality consistent level of care through the practice
- ◆ Delivers appropriate, safe, cost effective nursing care in a timely manner based on an individualized plan of care, and in accordance with approved standards of nursing care, to achieve positive patient outcomes.
